- 5 SECTION 1. Section 36.102, Water Code, is amended by

- 8 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (f), the [The] board by
- 9 rule may set reasonable civil penalties that the district may
- 10 recover from [against] any person for breach of any rule of the
- 11 district in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 [\$10,000] per day per
- 12 violation, and each day of a continuing violation constitutes a
- 13 separate violation.
- 14 (f) In an enforcement action brought by a district against a
- 15 person, the court may assess a penalty greater than the maximum
- 16 penalty authorized under Subsection (b) if the court determines
- 17 that the person gained an economic benefit as a result of the
- 18 <u>violation</u> that was greater than the maximum penalty under
- 19 Subsection (b). A penalty assessed under this subsection must be in
- 20 an amount determined by the court to be necessary and appropriate to
- 21 outweigh the economic benefit gained by the person as a result of
- 22 the violation and discourage future violations.
- SECTION 2. Section 36.102, Water Code, as amended by this
- 24 Act, applies only to a suit involving a groundwater conservation
