4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 501, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 501.115 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 501.115. VETERAN HOUSING PROGRAM. (a) The department
8	shall establish a housing program for inmates who are veterans who
9	served not less than 180 days on active duty in the United States
10	armed forces and were honorably discharged.
11	(b) The program established under Subsection (a) must:
12	(1) dedicate certain cellblocks or dormitories for use
13	in the program; and
14	(2) include procedures to:
15	(A) verify the eligibility of each inmate during
16	the diagnostic process; and
17	(B) allow an inmate who is a veteran described by
18	Subsection (a) to opt in to the housing dedicated for use in the
19	<pre>program under Subdivision (1).</pre>
20	(c) In housing inmates under the program established under
21	Subsection (a), the department:
22	(1) shall comply with the requirements of Section
23	501.112; and
24	(2) may not house an inmate in a cellblock or dormitory

- 1 dedicated for use in the program if the department determines that
- 2 housing the inmate in the cellblock or dormitory would jeopardize
- 3 the safety or security of other inmates or staff.
- 4 (d) A cellblock or dormitory dedicated for use in the
- 5 program under Subsection (b)(1) may, if necessary, be used to house
- 6 inmates who are not veterans described by Subsection (a).
- 7 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 8 of this Act, the Texas Department of Criminal Justice shall
- 9 establish the program required by Section 501.115, Government Code,
- 10 as added by this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
