A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the commissioners
- 2 court of a county to adopt an exemption from ad valorem taxation by
- 3 the county of a portion, expressed as a dollar amount, of the
- 4 appraised value of an individual's residence homestead.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1-b, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 7 is amended by adding Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (e-1) The commissioners court of a county by official action
- 9 may exempt from ad valorem taxation by the county a portion,
- 10 expressed as a dollar amount, of the appraised value of the
- 11 residence homestead of an individual. The amount of the exemption
- 12 may not exceed \$100,000. An eligible individual is entitled to
- 13 receive other applicable exemptions provided by law. Where ad
- 14 valorem tax has previously been pledged for the payment of debt, the
- 15 county may continue to levy and collect the tax against the value of
- 16 the homesteads exempted under this subsection until the debt is
- 17 discharged if the cessation of the levy would impair the obligation
- 18 of the contract by which the debt was created.
- 19 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 20 the Texas Constitution:
- 21 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 22 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 89th Legislature,
- 23 Regular Session, 2025, authorizing the commissioners court of a
- 24 county to adopt an exemption from ad valorem taxation by the county

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- 1 of a portion, expressed as a dollar amount, of the appraised value
- 2 of an individual's residence homestead.
- 3 (b) The amendment to Section 1-b, Article VIII, of this
- 4 constitution takes effect beginning with the tax year that begins
- 5 January 1, 2026.
- 6 (c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2027.
- 7 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 8 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
- 9 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 10 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 11 commissioners court of a county to adopt an exemption from ad
- 12 valorem taxation by the county of a portion, expressed as a dollar
- 13 amount, of the appraised value of an individual's residence
- 14 homestead."
