## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing a local option
- 2 exemption from ad valorem taxation of all or part of the appraised
- 3 value of the residence homesteads of certain peace officers.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1-b, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 6 is amended by adding Subsection (q) to read as follows:
- 7 (q) The governing body of a political subdivision may exempt
- 8 from ad valorem taxation all or part of the appraised value of the
- 9 residence homestead of an eligible peace officer. The governing
- 10 body may adopt the exemption as a specified dollar amount or as a
- 11 percentage of the appraised value of the residence homestead.
- 12 Where ad valorem tax of a political subdivision has previously been
- 13 pledged for the payment of debt, the taxing officers of the
- 14 political subdivision may continue to levy and collect the tax
- 15 against the value of residence homesteads exempted under this
- 16 subsection until the debt is discharged if the cessation of the levy
- 17 would impair the obligation of the contract by which the debt was
- 18 <u>created.</u> The legislature by general law may define "eligible peace
- 19 officer" for purposes of this subsection and may provide additional
- 20 eligibility requirements for the exemption.
- 21 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 22 the Texas Constitution:
- 23 <u>TEMPORARY PROVISION.</u> (a) This temporary provision applies
- 24 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 89th Legislature,

- 1 Regular Session, 2025, authorizing a local option exemption from ad
- 2 valorem taxation of all or part of the appraised value of the
- 3 residence homesteads of certain peace officers.
- 4 (b) The amendment to Section 1-b, Article VIII, of this
- 5 constitution takes effect January 1, 2026, and applies only to ad
- 6 valorem taxes imposed for a tax year beginning on or after that
- 7 <u>date</u>.
- 8 <u>(c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2027.</u>
- 9 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 10 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
- 11 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 12 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing a local
- 13 option exemption from ad valorem taxation of all or part of the
- 14 appraised value of the residence homesteads of certain peace
- 15 officers."
