1 WHEREAS, A life made rich through meaningful service drew to 2 a close with the passing of admired educator Albert Black of Austin 3 on August 11, 2024, at the age of 75; and WHEREAS, Born in Crockett on May 4, 1949, Albert Black 4 graduated from Paul Quinn College in 1970; he began his career as an 5 elementary school teacher and principal in the Waco Independent 6 7 School District; after earning a master's degree from Prairie View A&M University, he joined the Texas Education Agency and rose to 8 become a senior program director; he retired following a noteworthy 9 27-year tenure, but he was soon recruited by Child Inc, Head Start; 10 11 as executive director, he guided the expansion of center capacity, 12 implementation of innovative programs, and formation of strategic partnerships with local school districts, businesses, 13 14 nonprofit groups; the organization also realized improvements in performance measures and provided professional development 15 16 opportunities for staff; in April 2024, he was named president of 17 the Region VI Head Start Association Board; and 18 WHEREAS, Mr. Black married the former Kathy Gaither April 17, 1981, and they were blessed with two children, Kaneisha 19 20 and Elijah; eventually, his treasured family grew to include two 21 grandchildren, Karis and Trey; he was predeceased by his beloved daughter; a man of faith, he led the Men's Ministry at Mt. Zion 22 23 Baptist Church and served as Brotherhood Ministry president for the
