- 1 WHEREAS, World Down Syndrome Day is being held at the State
- 2 Capitol on March 21, 2025; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Down syndrome, the most commonly occurring
- 4 chromosomal condition, occurs in individuals who have a full or
- 5 partial extra copy of chromosome 21; one of every 700 babies born in
- 6 the United States each year is born with Down syndrome; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Medical advances have significantly increased the
- 8 life expectancy of people with Down syndrome, which is now
- 9 approaching that of peers without the condition; in addition to the
- 10 advantages of modern medicine, support groups and other resources
- 11 are now available in nearly every community in the United States;

- WHEREAS, When provided with quality education programs, a
- 14 stimulating home environment, good health care, and support from
- 15 family and friends, individuals with Down syndrome can lead
- 16 fulfilling and productive lives; much progress has been made
- 17 through the vision and hard work of parents, researchers, medical
- 18 professionals, and other advocates, who have helped promote
- 19 inclusivity and secure the rights of people with Down syndrome to
- 20 live at home, attend schools, access appropriate health care, get
- 21 married, find work, and contribute to society; and
- WHEREAS, In 2011, the United Nations General Assembly
- 23 declared March 21 as World Down Syndrome Day; this year, the State
- 24 of Texas is joining with countries around the globe in recognition

- 1 of this special event, and all Texans are encouraged to take part by

- 3 those living with Down syndrome; now, therefore, be it
