2 researcher drew to a close with the passing of Dr. William Peter 3 Kuvlesky Jr. of Kingsville on March 8, 2025, at the age of 67; and WHEREAS, The son of William and Eileen Kuvlesky, Bill 4 5 Kuvlesky was born in Bellefonte, Pennsylvania, on April 11, 1957, and he grew up in College Station with four siblings, Mike, Lisa, 6 Faith, and Andy; a graduate of A&M Consolidated High School, he 7 earned bachelor's and doctoral degrees in wildlife and fisheries 8 sciences from Texas A&M University and a master's degree in 9 wildlife ecology from the University of Wisconsin-Madison; after 10 11 completing his studies in 1990, he worked as a wildlife ecologist 12 for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and then as a wildlife biologist for the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service at the Buenos Aires 13 14 National Wildlife Refuge in Arizona; and 15 WHEREAS, In 1999, he joined the faculty of Texas A&M University-Kingsville as an assistant professor and research 16 scientist for the Caesar Kleberg Wildlife Research Institute and 17 the Department of Animal and Wildlife Sciences, and he was later 18 promoted to associate professor; in 2006, he concurrently assumed 19 the role of interim assistant dean for the Dick and Mary Lewis 20 21 Kleberg College of Agriculture and Natural Resources before being 22 permanently appointed the following year; his tenure at the 23 university spanned more than a quarter century, distinguished himself through his avian ecology research, his 24
