RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Residents of Kenedy are gathering on April 9, 2025,

- 2 to celebrate City of Kenedy Day at the State Capitol; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The town's modern-day site was bequeathed to Carlos
- 4 Martinez as part of a royal Spanish land grant in 1788; located
- 5 along the San Antonio and Aransas Pass Railway, the community was
- 6 established in 1886 as Kenedy Junction by chief SA&AP benefactor
- 7 Mifflin Kenedy; its post office opened in March 1887, and its name
- 8 was shortened to Kenedy three months later; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The town experienced significant growth as a trade
- 10 and business center during the railroad era, and it established a
- 11 depot, a cotton gin, and a number of newspapers; in 1894, the Kenedy
- 12 Independent School District was organized with 68 students, and the
- 13 town's first bank opened its doors nearly a decade later; in 1910,
- 14 the community was formally incorporated with a population of
- 15 approximately 1,150 residents; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Today, Kenedy remains an economic focal point for
- 17 Karnes County, which benefits from the farming, ranching, oil, gas,
- 18 and uranium industries; currently home to more than 3,400
- 19 residents, the self-proclaimed "flax capital of Texas" is centrally
- 20 located between the cities of San Antonio, Corpus Christi, and
- 21 Victoria, and it is at the epicenter of the Eagle Ford Shale; and
- WHEREAS, Celebrating their rich history as they work to build
- 23 an even brighter future, residents of Kenedy are justifiably proud
- 24 of their community, and it is indeed fitting to recognize the city's
