R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, All who shared in the life of Susana Imelda Alemán of
2 Austin were deeply saddened by her death on March 21, 2025, at the
3 age of 70; and

4 WHEREAS, The daughter of Élide Wilson Alemán and Manuel
5 Alemán, Susana Alemán was born in Edinburg on July 17, 1954, and she
6 grew up with the companionship of an older sister, Yolanda; when she
7 was eight years old, her family moved to Falfurrias, where she
8 graduated from Falfurrias High School as valedictorian in 1972; and

9 WHEREAS, Ms. Alemán attended The University of Texas at
10 Austin, earning her bachelor's degree magna cum laude in 1975, and
11 while working for the Austin Independent School District, she
12 attained her master's degree in curriculum and instruction; after
13 teaching civics at Falfurrias High School for four years, she went
14 on to earn her master's degree in school administration from Texas
15 A&I University and her juris doctor degree from the UT School of
16 Law; in 1984, Ms. Alemán became the assistant dean of student
17 affairs at the UT School of Law, a position she held for 22 years;

19 WHEREAS, Ms. Alemán was a passionate supporter of UT sports,
20 and her home decor reflected her Longhorn pride; a woman of faith,
21 she was a member of Saint Albert the Great Catholic Church, and in
22 2022, she was installed as a Dame in the Equestrian Order of the
23 Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem; caring and outgoing, she maintained
24 lifelong relationships with classmates, students, coworkers,

1 members of her church, and people from all walks of life; and

2 WHEREAS, Those fortunate enough to have known Susana Alemán
3 will remember the way she touched their lives with her kindness, her
4 generosity, and her positive outlook, and she will forever hold a
5 treasured place in their hearts; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 89th Texas
7 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Susana Imelda
8 Alemán and extend sincere condolences to the members of her family:
9 to her sister, Yolanda Wilson Alemán, and her husband, Christopher
