## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Dr. Sylvia Rios is retiring as superintendent of the 2 Laredo Independent School District in 2025, drawing to a close an 3 exemplary career in education spanning nearly five decades; and 4 WHEREAS, Dr. Rios first joined Laredo ISD in 2001 as 5 principal of Joseph W. Nixon High School, and under her direction, the campus was the first in the district to receive a "Recognized" 6 rating from the Texas Education Agency; she went on to become the 7 district's chief academic officer, and in 2017, she was unanimously 8 of LISD, 9 voted superintendent which at the time served approximately 24,000 students across 34 campuses; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Over the course of her distinguished tenure as 12 superintendent, Dr. Rios has placed a special emphasis on preparing for life after graduation; 13 students she has overseen 14 dual-enrollment programs and early college designations expanded opportunities for career certification and military 15 readiness; moreover, \$152 million in bond-funded construction and 16 renovation projects have taken place during her term, resulting in 17 18 new schools, refurbished vocational facilities, and upgraded administrative spaces; and 19 WHEREAS, Dr. Rios's dedicated efforts have helped Laredo ISD 20 21 earn a number of prestigious national and state awards; under her leadership, its campuses have received a total of 11 National Blue 22 23 Ribbon School titles, making the district one of the most
