- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 61.002, Election Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsections (a), (c), and (d) and adding Subsections (e)
- 6 and (f) to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Immediately before opening the polls for voting on the
- 8 first day of early voting and on election day, the presiding
- 9 election judge or alternate presiding [election] judge shall
- 10 confirm that each voting machine has any public counter reset to
- 11 zero and shall print the tape that shows the counter was set to zero
- 12 for each candidate or measure on the ballot.
- 13 (c) Immediately after closing the polls for voting on
- 14 election day and on the last day of early voting by personal
- 15 appearance, the presiding election judge or alternate presiding
- 16 [election] judge shall print the tape to show the number of votes
- 17 cast for each candidate or ballot measure for each voting machine.
- 18 (d) The presiding [Each] election judge and [or] alternate
- 19 presiding [election] judge [present] shall sign a tape printed
- 20 under this section.
- (e) When closing the polls on the last day of early voting,
- 22 the presiding election judge and alternate presiding judge shall
- 23 place a tape printed under this section in envelope no. 2.
- 24 (f) When closing the polls for voting on election day, any

- 1 watcher present, but not more than three, may sign a tape printed
- 2 under this section.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 61.007, Election Code, is amended by
- 4 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 5 (d) A person who prints a tape under Section 61.002 does not
- 6 commit an offense under this section.
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 66.023, Election Code, is amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 66.023. CONTENTS OF ENVELOPE NO. 2. Envelope no. 2
- 10 must contain:
- 11 (1) a copy of the precinct returns;
- 12 (2) a tally list;
- 13 (3) the original of the poll list;
- 14 (4) the signature roster;
- 15 (5) the precinct early voting list;
- 16 (6) any affidavits completed at the polling place
- 17 except affidavits required to be placed in envelope no. 4; [and]
- 18 (7) any certificates of appointment of watchers; and
- 19 (8) any voting machine tape printed for the purpose of
- 20 showing the number of votes cast.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
