- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 794, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 794.0001 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 794.0001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "illegal
- 8 alien" means a person who:
- 9 <u>(1) is not a citizen or national of the United States;</u>
- 10 and
- 11 (2) is unlawfully present in the United States
- 12 according to the terms of 8 U.S.C. Section 1101 et seq.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 794.003, Government Code, is amended to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 794.003. INTERSTATE COMPACT PROVISIONS. The compact
- 16 authorized by this chapter must provide for joint action among
- 17 compacting states on matters that include:
- 18 (1) sharing law enforcement intelligence on illegal
- 19 activity occurring at the border with Mexico;
- 20 (2) sharing state resources in order to build a
- 21 physical barrier, a comprehensive technological surveillance
- 22 system, or both, on state land to deter or detect illegal activity
- 23 occurring at the border with Mexico; [and]
- 24 (3) sharing other law enforcement resources to ensure

- 1 the protection of personnel and property;
- 2 (4) to the greatest extent possible given the
- 3 resources available, ensuring the operational control of the
- 4 Texas-Mexico border through the detection and apprehension or
- 5 deflection of illegal aliens attempting to cross that border into
- 6 this state;
- 7 (5) enforcing federal immigration laws, including the
- 8 laws governing detecting, apprehending, detaining, prosecuting,
- 9 releasing, and monitoring illegal aliens; and
- 10 (6) providing mutual support for the resources,
- 11 including infrastructure, equipment, software, and personnel, that
- 12 are necessary or convenient to ensure that the purposes described
- 13 by this section are adequately supported and achieved.
- 14 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act to Chapter
- 15 794, Government Code, apply only to an interstate compact entered
- 16 into under that chapter on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 An interstate compact entered into under that chapter before the
- 18 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 19 date the interstate compact was entered into, and the former law is
- 20 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
