- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 48.005(a) and (i), Education Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) In this chapter, average daily attendance is:
- 8 (1) the quotient of the sum of attendance for each day
- 9 of the minimum number of days of instruction as described under
- 10 Section 25.081(a) divided by the minimum number of days of
- 11 instruction;
- 12 (2) for a district that operates under a flexible year
- 13 program under Section 29.0821, the quotient of the sum of
- 14 attendance for each actual day of instruction as permitted by
- 15 Section 29.0821(b)(1) divided by the number of actual days of
- 16 instruction as permitted by Section 29.0821(b)(1);
- 17 (3) for a district that operates under a flexible
- 18 school day program under Section 29.0822, the average daily
- 19 attendance as calculated by the commissioner in accordance with
- 20 Sections 29.0822(d) and (d-1); or
- 21 (4) for a district that operates a prekindergarten
- 22 [half-day program or a full-day] program under Section 29.153(c):
- (A) for a half-day program, one-half of the
- 24 average daily attendance calculated under Subdivision (1); or

- 1 (B) for a full-day program, the average daily
- 2 <u>attendance calculated under Subdivision (1)</u>.
- 3 (i) A district or a charter school operating under Chapter
- 4 12 that operates a half-day prekindergarten program is eligible to
- 5 receive one-half of average daily attendance under Subsection (a)
- 6 if the district's or charter school's prekindergarten program
- 7 provides at least 32,400 minutes of instructional time to students.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
