Subchapter H, Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Section 1701.3526 to read as follows: 19 Sec. 1701.3526. CONTINUING EDUCATION ON OPIOID OVERDOSES. 20 As part of the continuing education programs under Section 21 1701.351(a), an officer shall complete the training program on 22 23 opioid overdoses established under Section 1701.273. 24 SECTION 4. As soon as practicable after the effective date

1 of this Act, the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement shall adopt 2 rules to implement the changes in law made by this Act.

3 SECTION 5. The minimum curriculum requirements under 4 Section 1701.253(u), Occupations Code, as added by this Act, apply 5 only to an officer who first begins to satisfy those requirements on 6 or after January 1, 2026.

7 SECTION 6. Section 1701.3526, Occupations Code, as added by 8 this Act, applies only with respect to a 24-month continuing 9 education training unit that begins on or after the effective date 10 of this Act. A training unit that begins before the effective date 11 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the training 12 unit began, and the former law is continued in effect for that 13 purpose.

14 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
