- 2 relating to the expansion of eligibility for Medicaid to certain

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,
- 7 is amended by adding Section 32.02473 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 32.02473. EXPANDED ELIGIBILITY FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE
- 9 UNDER PATIENT PROTECTION AND AFFORDABLE CARE ACT. (a)
- 10 Notwithstanding any other law, the commission shall provide medical
- 11 assistance to all individuals who apply for that assistance and for
- 12 whom federal matching money is available under the Patient
- 13 Protection and Affordable Care Act (Pub. L. No. 111-148), as
- 14 amended by the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010
- 15 (Pub. L. No. 111-152), to provide that assistance.
- 16 (b) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules regarding
- 17 the provision of medical assistance as required by this section.
- SECTION 2. Section 32.02473, Human Resources Code, as added
- 19 by this Act, applies only to an initial determination or
- 20 recertification of eligibility of an individual for medical
- 21 assistance under Chapter 32, Human Resources Code, made on or after
- 22 the date the section is implemented, regardless of the date the
- 23 individual applied for that assistance.
- 24 SECTION 3. As soon as possible after the effective date of

- 1 this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 2 Services Commission shall take all necessary actions to expand
- 3 eligibility for medical assistance under Chapter 32, Human
- 4 Resources Code, in accordance with Section 32.02473, Human
- 5 Resources Code, as added by this Act, including notifying
- 6 appropriate federal agencies of that expanded eligibility.
- 7 SECTION 4. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 8 a state agency determines that any other waiver or authorization
- 9 from a federal agency is necessary for implementation of that
- 10 provision, the agency affected by the provision shall request the
- 11 waiver or authorization and may delay implementing that provision
- 12 until the waiver or authorization is granted.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
