- 5 SECTION 1. Section 48.115, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c-2) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), a school
- 9 district is entitled to an annual allotment equal to the sum of the
- 10 following amounts or a greater amount provided by appropriation:
- 11 (1) \$14 [\$10] for each student in average daily
- 12 attendance, plus \$1 for each student in average daily attendance
- 13 per every \$50 by which the district's maximum basic allotment under
- 14 Section 48.051 exceeds \$6,160, prorated as necessary; and
- 15 (2) $\$37,000 \ [\$15,000]$ per campus.
- 16 (c-2) Not later than December 1 of each year, each school
- 17 district shall submit to the agency a report accounting for the
- 18 expenditure of funds received under this section.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
