1-26 AN ACT

1-27 relating to the school safety allotment under the Foundation School
1-28 Program.

1-29 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-30 SECTION 1. Section 48.115(a), Education Code, is amended to
1-31 read as follows:

1-32 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), a school
1-33 district is entitled to an annual allotment equal to the sum of the
1-34 following amounts or a greater amount provided by appropriation:

1-35 (1) \$28 [~~\$10~~] for each student in average daily
1-36 attendance, plus \$1 for each student in average daily attendance
1-37 per every \$50 by which the district's maximum basic allotment under
1-38 Section 48.051 exceeds \$6,160, prorated as necessary; and

1-39 (2) \$30,000 [~~\$15,000~~] per campus.

1-40 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
