relating to the school safety allotment under the Foundation School 1-27 1-28 Program. 1-29

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 48.115(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), a school district is entitled to an annual allotment equal to the sum of the

following amounts or a greater amount provided by appropriation:

(1)  $\frac{$28}{$10}$  [\$10] for each student in average daily attendance, plus \$1 for each student in average daily attendance per every \$50 by which the district's maximum basic allotment under Section 48.051 exceeds \$6,160, prorated as necessary; and

(2) \$30,000 [\$15,000] per campus.
SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025. 1-40
