## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to air quality permits for concrete crushing facilities
3	and concrete plants located in certain areas.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 382, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 382.051991 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 382.051991. MUNICIPAL OR COUNTY APPROVAL OF CERTAIN
8	CONCRETE FACILITIES. (a) This section applies only to an
9	application for a permit or an authorization to use a permit for a
10	<pre>facility that is:</pre>
11	(1) a concrete crushing facility or a concrete plant
12	that performs wet batching, dry batching, or central mixing; and
13	(2) located or proposed to be located in:
14	(A) an incorporated area of a municipality that
15	has not adopted zoning regulations and has a population of more than
16	two million; or
17	(B) an unincorporated area of a county with a
18	population of more than 4.5 million.
19	(b) This section does not apply to an application for an
20	authorization to use a standard permit under Section 382.051985.
21	(c) For each application described by Subsection (a), the
22	<pre>commission:</pre>
23	(1) shall send to the governing body of the
24	municipality or county, as applicable, a copy of the application;

- 2 (2) may not issue the permit or authorize the use of
- 3 the permit before the 31st day after the date the governing body
- 4 receives the copy unless the commission receives notice that the
- 5 governing body has approved the application.
- 6 (d) The commission may not issue a permit or authorize the
- 7 use of a permit under Section 382.0518, 382.05195, 382.05196, or
- 8 382.05198 or another provision of this chapter for a facility
- 9 described by Subsection (a) if the commission receives, before the
- 10 31st day after the date the governing body receives the copy of the
- 11 application from the commission, notice that the governing body has
- 12 rejected the application.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 382.051991, Health and Safety Code, as
- 14 added by this Act, applies only to a permit or authorization the
- 15 application for which is filed with the Texas Commission on
- 16 Environmental Quality on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 17 permit or authorization the application for which is filed before
- 18 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on
- 19 the date of filing, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 20 purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
