S.B. No. 279

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to contested case hearings on the issuance, renewal, or
3 revocation of authorizations to use certain standard air quality
4 permits.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 382.05195, Health and Safety Code, is
7 amended by amending Subsection (g) and adding Subsection (g-1) to
8 read as follows:

9 (g) Except as provided by Subsection (g-1), the ~~[The]~~
10 adoption or amendment of a standard permit or the issuance,
11 renewal, or revocation of an authorization to use a standard permit
12 is not subject to Chapter 2001, Government Code.

13 (g-1) A person may request a contested case hearing on the
14 issuance, renewal, or revocation of an authorization to use a
15 standard permit if the person alleges that the issuance, renewal,
16 or revocation is in conflict with a provision of this chapter. A
17 contested case hearing under this subsection is subject to the
18 requirements of Subchapters C through G, Chapter 2001, Government
19 Code, and Section 5.556, Water Code.

20 SECTION 2. Section 382.05195(g-1), Health and Safety Code,
21 as added by this Act, applies only to the issuance, renewal, or
22 revocation of an authorization to use a standard permit the
23 application for which is filed on or after the effective date of
24 this Act. The issuance, renewal, or revocation of an authorization

1 to use a standard permit the application for which was filed before
2 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at
3 the time the application was filed, and the former law is continued
4 in effect for that purpose.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
