- 17 contested case hearing under this subsection is subject to the

- SECTION 2. Section 382.05195(g-1), Health and Safety Code,
- 21 as added by this Act, applies only to the issuance, renewal, or

- 1 to use a standard permit the application for which was filed before
- 2 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at
- 3 the time the application was filed, and the former law is continued
- 4 in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
