## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the repeal of certain laws prohibiting abortion.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 171.206(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (b) This subchapter may not be construed to:
- 7 (1) authorize the initiation of a cause of action
- 8 against or the prosecution of a <u>pregnant individual</u> [woman] on whom
- 9 an abortion is performed or induced or attempted to be performed or
- 10 induced in violation of this subchapter;
- 11 (2) wholly or partly repeal, either expressly or by
- 12 implication, any other statute that regulates or prohibits
- 13 abortion[, including Chapter 6-1/2, Title 71, Revised Statutes]; or
- 14 (3) restrict a political subdivision from regulating
- 15 or prohibiting abortion in a manner that is at least as stringent as
- 16 the laws of this state.
- SECTION 2. Section 171.207(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 (b) Subsection (a) may not be construed to:
- 20 (1) legalize the conduct prohibited by this subchapter
- 21 [or by Chapter 6-1/2, Title 71, Revised Statutes];
- 22 (2) limit in any way or affect the availability of a
- 23 remedy established by Section 171.208; or
- 24 (3) limit the enforceability of any other laws that

- 1 regulate or prohibit abortion.
- 2 SECTION 3. The following laws are repealed:
- 3 (1) Chapter 170A, Health and Safety Code; and
- 4 (2) Chapter 6-1/2, Title 71, Revised Statutes.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
