5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter L, Chapter 2166, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 2166.555 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 2166.555. INTERNATIONAL BORDER WALL. (a) The
9	commission may exercise the power of eminent domain under Section
10	2166.055 to acquire an interest in real property for the
11	construction, extension, improvement, or development of a wall
12	along this state's international border for the purposes of
13	preventing:
14	(1) human trafficking; and
15	(2) illegal entry into the United States of:
16	(A) aliens without official approval of an
17	appropriate federal governmental authority;
18	(B) terrorists and instruments of terrorism; and
19	(C) contraband, including narcotics and other
20	controlled substances.
21	(b) The commission may exercise the power of eminent domain
22	under Subsection (a) to acquire:
23	(1) land in fee simple; or
24	(2) any interest less than fee simple in, on, under, or

1	above land, including an easement, right-of-way, or right of use of
2	airspace or subsurface space.
3	(c) The commission must adopt a resolution in accordance
4	with Section 2206.053 before filing a condemnation petition under
5	Chapter 21, Property Code, to exercise the power of eminent domain
6	under this section.
7	(d) The resolution required by Subsection (c):
8	(1) must include a statement that the commission's
9	acquisition of the property interest described in the resolution:
10	(A) is a public necessity; and
11	(B) is necessary and proper for the construction,
12	extension, improvement, or development of a wall along this state's
13	international border and is in the public interest; and
14	(2) is conclusive evidence of the public necessity of
15	the proposed acquisition and that the property interest is
16	necessary for public use.
17	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
