- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 232.0015(c) and (f), Local Government
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A county may not require the owner of a tract of land
- 8 located outside the limits of a municipality who divides the tract
- 9 into two or more parts to have a plat of the subdivision prepared
- 10 if:
- 11 (1) the owner does not lay out:
- 12 <u>(A)</u> a part of the tract described by Section
- 13 232.001(a)(3); or
- 14 (B) one or more streets, alleys, squares, parks,
- 15 or other parts of the tract intended for the use of purchasers or
- 16 owners of lots fronting on or adjacent to the streets, alleys,
- 17 squares, parks, or other parts; and
- 18 (2) the land is to be used primarily for agricultural
- 19 use, as defined by Section 1-d, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 20 or for farm, ranch, wildlife management, or timber production use
- 21 within the meaning of Section 1-d-1, Article VIII, Texas
- 22 Constitution.
- 23 (f) A county may not require the owner of a tract of land
- 24 located outside the limits of a municipality who divides the tract

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- 1 into two or more parts to have a plat of the subdivision prepared
- 2 if:
- 3 (1) all of the lots of the subdivision are more than 10
- 4 acres in area; and
- 5 (2) the owner does not lay out:
- 6 (A) a part of the tract described by Section
- 7 232.001(a)(3); or
- 8 (B) one or more streets, alleys, squares, parks,
- 9 or other parts of the tract intended for the use of purchasers or
- 10 owners of lots fronting on or adjacent to the streets, alleys,
- 11 squares, parks, or other parts.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 35.019(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 (a) Notwithstanding Section 232.001(h), Local Government
- 15 <u>Code, the [The]</u> commissioners court of a county in a priority
- 16 groundwater management area may adopt water availability
- 17 requirements in an area where platting is required if the court
- 18 determines that the requirements are necessary to prevent current
- 19 or projected water use in the county from exceeding the safe
- 20 sustainable yield of the county's water supply.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
