17	(1) as applicable, address the specific consent
18	documentation required for:
19	(A) telemedicine medical services;
20	(B) teledentistry dental services; or
21	(C) telehealth services; and
22	(2) include provisions, based on the appropriate
23	standard of care, for consent documentation in an audio-only
