1 of this Act, the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement shall adopt 2 rules to implement Sections 1701.253(u), 1701.264(c), and 3 1701.265(c), Occupations Code, as added by this Act.

4 SECTION 5. The minimum curriculum requirements under 5 Section 1701.253(u), Occupations Code, as added by this Act, apply 6 only to an officer who first begins to satisfy those requirements on 7 or after January 1, 2026.
