2 relating to a report by the Public Utility Commission of Texas on
3 disconnections of residential retail electric service.
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 17, Utilities Code, is

6 amended by adding Section 17.054 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 17.054. SUMMER RESIDENTIAL SERVICE DISCONNECTION REPORT. (a) Not later than June 1 of each year, the commission 8 9 shall create and publish on the commission's Internet website a report of the total number of residential customers of retail 10 electric service in this state whose accounts are disconnected for 11 nonpayment of bills as of the date of the report. Until September 12 30 of each year, the commission shall update the report at least 13 14 weekly to show the total number of residential customers of retail electric service whose accounts are disconnected for nonpayment of 15

16 bills at the time of the update. (b) The commission by rule may require any entity under the 17 commission's jurisdiction that provides retail electric service to 18 a residential customer and any other market participant under the 19 commission's jurisdiction to submit to the commission information 20 necessary for the commission to comply with Subsection (a). 21 rules must prescribe the nature and detail of the required 22 23 information.

24 SECTION 2. The Public Utility Commission of Texas shall

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- 1 publish the first report required under Section 17.054, Utilities
- 2 Code, as added by this Act, not later than June 1, 2026.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
