## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a requirement that certain special purpose districts
3	cause certain information to be posted on an Internet website.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 2051.202, Government Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsections (a), (b), and (d) and adding Subsections (b-1)
7	and (e) to read as follows:
8	(a) In this section, "special purpose district" has the
9	meaning assigned by Section 403.0241 [means a political subdivision
10	of this state with geographic boundaries that define the
11	subdivision's territorial jurisdiction. The term does not include
12	a municipality, county, junior college district, independent
13	school district, groundwater conservation district, river
14	authority, or political subdivision with statewide jurisdiction].
15	(b) This section applies only to a special purpose district
16	<pre>described by Section 403.0241(b) [that:</pre>
17	[(1) is authorized by the state by a general or special
18	law to impose an ad valorem tax;
19	[(2) during the most recent fiscal year imposed an ad
20	<pre>valorem tax;</pre>
21	[(3) during the most recent fiscal year:
22	[(A) had bonds outstanding;
23	[(B) had gross receipts from operations, loans,
24	taxes, or contributions in excess of \$250,000; or

1 [(C) had cash and temporary investments in excess

2 of \$250,000; and

- 3 [(4) at the beginning of the most recent fiscal year,
- 4 had a population of 500 or more, as determined by the governing body
- 5 of the special purpose district].
- 6 (b-1) This section does not apply to a groundwater
- 7 conservation district or a river authority.
- 8 (d) A special purpose district shall post or cause to be
- 9 posted on an Internet website the following information, if
- 10 applicable:
- 11 (1) the name of the special purpose district;
- 12 (2) the name and term of office of each member of the
- 13 governing body of the special purpose district;
- 14 (3) the contact information for the main office of the
- 15 special purpose district, including the physical address, the
- 16 mailing address, and the telephone number;
- 17 (4) the official contact information for each member
- 18 of the governing body of the special purpose district;
- 19 (5) if the special purpose district employs a person
- 20 as a general manager or executive director, or in another position
- 21 to perform duties or functions comparable to those of a general
- 22 manager or executive director, the name of the general manager,
- 23 executive director, or person that performs those duties;
- 24 (6) if the special purpose district contracts with a
- 25 utility operator, the contact information for a person representing
- 26 the utility operator, including a mailing address and telephone
- 27 number;

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- 1 (7) if the special purpose district contracts with a
- 2 tax assessor-collector, the contact information for a person
- 3 representing the tax assessor-collector, including a mailing
- 4 address and telephone number;
- 5 (8) if the special purpose district imposes an ad
- 6 valorem tax, the rate of the ad valorem tax of the special purpose
- 7 district;
- 8 (9) if the special purpose district imposes a sales
- 9 and use tax, the rate of the sales and use tax of the special purpose
- 10 district;
- 11 (10) any notice of tax hearing required to be given
- 12 under Chapter 26, Tax Code, or Section 49.236, Water Code;
- 13 (11) the location and schedule of meetings of the
- 14 governing body of the special purpose district;
- 15 (12) a statement substantially similar to the
- 16 following: "Residents of the district have the right to request the
- 17 designation of a meeting location within the district under Section
- 18 49.062(g), Water Code. A description of this process can be found at
- 19 (insert link to the Internet website described by Section
- 20 49.062(g), Water Code).";
- 21 (13) each notice of a meeting of the governing body of
- 22 the special purpose district under Subchapter C, Chapter 551, for
- 23 meetings conducted in the current calendar year and the immediately
- 24 preceding calendar year;
- 25 (14) the minutes of a public meeting of the governing
- 26 body of the special purpose district under Section 551.021 for
- 27 meetings conducted in the current calendar year and the immediately

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- 1 preceding calendar year; [and]
- 2 (15) the most recent financial audit of the special
- 3 purpose district; and
- 4 (16) if the special purpose district has elected
- 5 officers:
- 6 (A) the date and location of the next election
- 7 for each office; and
- 8 (B) the requirements and deadline for filing for
- 9 candidacy for each office.
- 10 (e) A special purpose district must post the information
- 11 required by Subsection (d)(16)(B) continuously for at least one
- 12 year before the date of the election for the office.
- SECTION 2. Section 2051.201(c), Government Code, is
- 14 repealed.
- SECTION 3. Section 2051.202(e), Government Code, as added
- 16 by this Act, applies only to an office the election for which takes
- 17 place after January 1, 2027.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
