In this subchapter, "victim" 11 means a person who is the subject of: 12 13 (1) an offense that allegedly constitutes: 14 (A) stalking under Section 42.072, Penal Code; (B) invasive visual recording under Section 15 16 21.15, Penal Code; or (C) indecent assault under Section 22.012, Penal 17 <u>Code</u>; or 18 (2) an offense that is part of the same criminal 19 episode, as defined by Section 3.01, Penal Code, as an offense 20 described by Subdivision (1) [under Section 42.072, Penal Code]. 21 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
