- 7 Sec. 562.0035. PROTECTED DISCLOSURES AND COMMUNICATIONS BY
- 8 PHARMACISTS AND PHARMACIES REGARDING PRESCRIPTION DRUG BENEFITS.
- 9 (a) In this section, "enrollee" means an individual who is covered
- 10 under a health benefit plan, including a covered dependent.
- 11 (b) A pharmacist or pharmacy may not enter into a contract
- 12 or agreement or implement or effectuate a policy that prohibits or
- 13 restricts the pharmacist or pharmacy from:
- 14 (1) informing an enrollee of any difference between
- 15 the enrollee's out-of-pocket cost for a prescription drug under the
- 16 enrollee's health benefit plan and the out-of-pocket cost without
- 17 submitting a claim under the enrollee's health benefit plan; or
- 18 (2) communicating with sponsors of an enrollee's
- 19 health benefit plan regarding member services with respect to
- 20 prescription drug benefits, pharmacy services and benefits,
- 21 network access and adequacy with respect to prescription drug
- 22 benefits, partnership opportunities, or prescription claim
