4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 25.1902(b-1), Government Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (b-1) In addition to the jurisdiction provided by
8 Subsections (a) and (b), the county courts at law in [~~County Court~~
9 ~~at Law No. 1 of~~] Potter County have [~~has~~] concurrent jurisdiction
10 with the district court in felony cases to conduct arraignments,
11 conduct pretrial hearings, and accept pleas in uncontested matters.

12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
