4	SECTION 1. Section 547.701, Transportation Code, is amended
5	by amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (f) to read as

7	(e) In this subsection, "bus" includes a school bus, school
8	activity bus, multifunction school activity bus, or
9	school-chartered bus. Except as otherwise provided by this
10	subsection, a [A] bus operated by or contracted for use by a school
11	district for the transportation of schoolchildren shall be equipped
12	with a three-point seat belt for each passenger, including the
13	operator. A bus shall be equipped with a two-point seat belt for
14	each passenger, including the operator, if the board of trustees
15	for the school district:
16	(1) determines it is not feasible, in consideration of
17	the district's budget and student needs, for the district to equip
18	the district's buses with three-point seat belts as required by
19	this subsection; and
20	(2) [This subsection does not apply to:
21	[(1) a bus purchased by a school district that is a
22	model year 2017 or earlier; or
23	[(2) a bus purchased by a school district that is a
24	model year 2018 or later if the board of trustees for the school

- 2 [(A) determines that the district's budget does
- 3 not permit the district to purchase a bus that is equipped with the
- 4 seat belts required by this subsection; and

- 7 (f) A school district may accept gifts, grants, and
