- 12 being integrated into a regional water supply, sewer, wastewater
- 13 treatment, or solid waste disposal service <u>administered by another</u>
- 14 entity, including a retail public utility, the commission may enter
- 15 into a compliance agreement with the regional service under which
- 16 the commission will not initiate an enforcement action against the
- 17 regional service for existing or anticipated violations resulting
- 18 from the operation by the regional service of the service being
- 19 integrated. A compliance agreement under this section must
- 20 include provisions necessary to bring the service being integrated
- 21 into compliance.
- (c) If a water supply, sewer, or wastewater treatment
- 23 service operated by a retail public utility, other than a
- 24 municipality or county, is being integrated into a regional water

- 1 supply, sewer, or wastewater treatment service administered by
- 2 another entity, including a separate retail public utility, the
- 3 commission may enter into a compliance agreement with the regional
- 4 service under which the commission will not initiate an enforcement

- 6 violations resulting from the operation by the regional service of
