- 1 outstanding balance, after copayments, deductibles, and
- 2 coinsurance, owed to an emergency care provider or a facility-based
- 3 provider for an out-of-network benefit claim; [ex]
- 4 (6) <u>a criminal conviction or juvenile adjudication of</u>
- 5 <u>a person who is at least 21 years of age, that occurred when the</u>
- 6 person was younger than 18 years of age, and for which the person
- 7 <u>completed the person's sentence; or</u>
- 8 $\underline{(7)}$ another item or event that predates the consumer
- 9 report by more than seven years.
- 10 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 11 20.05(a), Business & Commerce Code, applies only to a consumer
- 12 report furnished on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 13 consumer report furnished before the effective date of this Act is
- 14 governed by the law in effect on the date the report was furnished,
- 15 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
