4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 711.031, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
7	(a-1) A rule adopted under Subsection (a)(3) may:
8	(1) specify the style, color, size, and installation
9	requirements of a marker, memorial, or effigy; and
10	(2) require a marker or memorial to be installed flat
11	or erect.
12	SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 711, Health and Safety
13	Code, is amended by adding Section 711.0325 to read as follows:
14	Sec. 711.0325. PROHIBITED RULES ON MARKERS, MEMORIALS, AND
15	EFFIGIES; CIVIL PENALTY. (a) A cemetery organization may not adopt
16	or enforce a rule imposing a restriction or limitation on a business
17	from which a plot owner may:
18	(1) purchase a marker, memorial, or effigy; or
19	(2) contract for the installation of a marker,
20	memorial, or effigy.
21	(b) A cemetery organization that violates Subsection (a) is
22	liable for a civil penalty of not more than \$5,000 for each
23	violation. Each day a violation continues is considered a separate

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violation for purposes of assessing the civil penalty.

- 1 (c) The attorney general may bring suit to recover the civil
- 2 penalty authorized by Subsection (b).
- 3 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 4 violation by a cemetery organization that occurs on or after the
- 5 effective date of this Act. A violation that occurs before the
- 6 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 7 date the violation occurred, and the former law is continued in
- 8 effect for that purpose.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
