SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not apply to an offense if the prosecution of that offense becomes barred by limitation before the effective date of this Act. The prosecution of that offense remains barred as if this Act had not taken effect. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
