## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 109.61, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
7	amended by adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to read as follows:
8	(a-1) A person shall access electronically readable
9	information on a driver's license, commercial driver's license, or
10	identification certificate for the purpose of verifying a
11	purchaser's age in any retail sale of an alcoholic beverage.
12	(a-2) The commission may not take any disciplinary action
13	against the holder of a permit or license issued under this code for
14	a violation of Subsection (a-1) for the retail sale of an alcoholic
15	beverage made before September 1, 2027. This subsection expires
16	September 1. 2028.

- SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2027, the Texas
- 18 Alcoholic Beverage Commission shall adopt rules to implement
- 19 Section 109.61(a-1), Alcoholic Beverage Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
