## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to immunity for ringside physicians assigned to combative

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 2052, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 2052.255 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2052.255. IMMUNITY FOR RINGSIDE PHYSICIANS.
- 8 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section, a ringside
- 9 physician is immune from civil liability arising from acts within
- 10 the scope of the physician's responsibilities at a combative sports
- 11 event.
- 12 (b) The immunity from civil liability provided by
- 13 Subsection (a) does not apply to a cause of action arising from an
- 14 act or omission constituting gross negligence of the physician.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 2052.255, Occupations Code, as added by
- 16 this Act, applies only to an action commenced on or after the
- 17 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
