- 10 the member or employee communicates with a member of the appraisal
- 11 review board who is employed by the school district as a teacher
- 12 with the intent to influence a decision by the member in the
- 13 member's capacity as a member of the appraisal review board.
- SECTION 2. Section 6.412(c), Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 15 follows:
- 16 (c) Except as otherwise provided by this subsection, a [A]
- 17 person is ineligible to serve on the appraisal review board if the
- 18 person is a member of the board of directors, [an] officer, or
- 19 employee of the appraisal district, an employee of the comptroller,
- 20 or a member of the governing body, officer, or employee of a taxing
- 21 unit. A person employed by a school district as a teacher may serve
- 22 on the appraisal review board.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
