- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1952.103(c), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) Except as otherwise provided by this subsection, a [A]
- 8 code enforcement officer in training may engage in code enforcement
- 9 under the supervision of a registered code enforcement officer. $\underline{\text{If}}$
- 10 the employer of the code enforcement officer in training does not
- 11 also employ a registered code enforcement officer, the officer in
- 12 training may engage in code enforcement without supervision.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
