A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

S.B. No. 1555

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a grant program to fund certain railroad grade
- 3 separation projects.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 471, Transportation Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 471.010 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 471.010. GRANT PROGRAM FOR CERTAIN RAILROAD GRADE
- 8 SEPARATION PROJECTS. (a) For the purpose of increasing public
- 9 safety, enhancing economic development, and reducing traffic, the
- 10 department shall establish and administer a program to award grants
- 11 to political subdivisions of this state or railroad companies to
- 12 fund:
- 13 (1) rail-roadway grade separation projects that are
- 14 located at intersections of railroads and roadways that are not
- 15 part of the state highway system; and
- 16 (2) rail-pedestrian grade separation projects that
- 17 are located at intersections of railroads and pedestrian crossings.
- 18 (b) A political subdivision or railroad company may use
- 19 money awarded by the department under this section as matching
- 20 funds to secure additional funding for a grade separation project
- 21 described by Subsection (a).
- (c) Each grant awarded under this section must be approved
- 23 by the commission. The commission may not approve a grant under
- 24 this section unless the commission determines that:

- 1 (1) at least 10 percent of the total project costs will
- 2 be provided by a source other than the state; or
- 3 (2) if the grant money is being used as matching funds
- 4 under Subsection (b), at least 10 percent of the amount used as
- 5 matching funds will be provided by a source other than the state.
- 6 (d) The department may fund the grant program under this
- 7 section only from money appropriated by the legislature for that
- 8 purpose and from gifts and grants, including grants from the
- 9 federal government. The department may solicit and accept gifts
- 10 and grants from any source for the purposes of this section. Money
- 11 deposited to the credit of the state highway fund may not be used to
- 12 fund a grant awarded under this section.
- 13 <u>(e) The commission shall adopt rules as necessary to</u>
- 14 implement this section.
- SECTION 2. Not later than October 1, 2025, the Texas
- 16 Transportation Commission shall adopt the rules required by Section
- 17 471.010, Transportation Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
