- 7 (c) Except as otherwise provided by this subsection,
- 8 <u>recklessness</u> [Recklessness] and danger are presumed if the actor
- 9 knowingly pointed a firearm at or in the direction of another
- 10 whether or not the actor believed the firearm to be loaded. The
- 11 presumption under this subsection does not apply to a peace officer
- 12 engaged in the lawful discharge of the officer's official duties.
- (f) Subsection (b)(1) does not apply to a peace officer
- 14 engaged in the lawful discharge of the officer's official duties.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 19 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 20 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 21 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 22 before that date.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
