- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Chapter 91, Natural Resources Code, is amended
- 8 by adding Subchapter U to read as follows:

9 SUBCHAPTER U. OIL OR GAS EMERGENCIES

- Sec. 91.951. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "oil or gas
- 11 emergency" means an emergency related to the production, storage,
- 12 or transportation of oil or gas, including the uncontrolled release
- of oil, gas, or water from an oil or gas well.
- Sec. 91.952. EMERGENCY DECLARATION. (a) The commission by
- 15 proclamation may declare an oil or gas emergency if the commission
- 16 finds that an oil or gas emergency has occurred. A proclamation
- 17 issued under this section must include:
- 18 <u>(1) a description of the nature of the oil or gas</u>
- 19 emergency; and
- 20 (2) a designation of the area threatened by the oil or
- 21 gas emergency.
- 22 (b) An emergency proclamation issued under Subsection (a)
- 23 may not continue for more than 30 days unless renewed by the
- 24 commission.

- 1 Sec. 91.953. EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE. (a) Except in the case
- 2 of gross negligence, recklessness, or intentional misconduct, a
- 3 person is immune from civil liability for an act or omission that
- 4 occurs in giving assistance, advice, or resources, including the
- 5 use of the person's assets, employees, or contractors, with respect
- 6 to the management of an oil or gas emergency:
- 7 (1) that is declared by the commission under Section
- 8 <u>91.952; a</u>nd
- 9 (2) in which the assistance, advice, or resources are
- 10 provided at the request of an authorized representative of a state,
- 11 local, or federal agency.
- 12 (b) The immunities provided by this section are in addition
- 13 to any other immunity or limitations of liability provided by law.
- 14 SECTION 2. Subchapter U, Chapter 91, Natural Resources
- 15 Code, as added by this Act, does not apply to a cause of action that
- 16 accrued before the effective date of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
