## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the payment of certain fines and costs by a defendant.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article 42.15, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 5 amended by adding Subsection (a-3) and amending Subsection (b) to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a-3) When imposing fines and costs, a court may not require
- 8 <u>a defendant to pay more than five percent of the defendant's monthly</u>
- 9 income to satisfy the fines and costs, without the agreement of the
- 10 defendant.
- 11 (b) Subject to Subsections  $(a-3)_{,}$  (c)  $_{,}$  and (d) and Article
- 12 43.091, when imposing fines [a fine] and costs, a court may direct a
- 13 defendant:
- 14 (1) to pay the entire amount of fines [fine] and costs
- 15 when sentence is pronounced;
- 16 (2) to pay the entire <u>amount of fines</u> [fine] and costs
- 17 at some later date; or
- 18 (3) to pay a specified portion of the <u>fines</u> [fine] and
- 19 costs at designated intervals.
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 21 defendant who is sentenced for an offense on or after the effective
- 22 date of this Act, regardless of whether the offense is committed
- 23 before, on, or after that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
