1-17 relating to the use of telemedicine services in the juvenile

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-20 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 244, Human Resources Code,
1-21 is amended by adding Section 244.0095 to read as follows:
1-22 Sec. 244.0095. CERTAIN MEDICAL CARE SERVICES REQUIRED. In
1-23 providing medical care, the department shall contract for
1-24 telemedicine services to be available when a physician, advanced
1-25 practice registered nurse, or physician assistant is not present at
1-26 the facility where the services are to be provided.
1-27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
