S.B. No. 1782

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the maintenance of criminal history record information
- 3 for group home applicants and employees; creating a criminal
- 4 offense.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 769, Health and Safety Code, as added by
- 7 Chapter 141 (S.B. 188), Acts of the 88th Legislature, Regular
- 8 Session, 2023, is redesignated as Chapter 767, Health and Safety
- 9 Code, and amended to read as follows:
- 10 CHAPTER 767 [769]. REGULATION OF CERTAIN GROUP HOMES
- 11 Sec. 767.001 [769.001]. DEFINITION. In this chapter,
- 12 "group home" means an establishment that:
- 13 (1) provides, in one or more buildings, lodging to
- 14 three or more residents who are unrelated by blood or marriage to
- 15 the owner of the establishment; and
- 16 (2) provides those residents with community meals,
- 17 light housework, meal preparation, transportation, grocery
- 18 shopping, money management, laundry services, or assistance with
- 19 self-administration of medication but does not provide personal
- 20 care services as defined by Section 247.002.
- Sec. $\overline{767.002}$ [$\overline{769.002}$]. EXEMPTIONS. This chapter does not
- 22 apply to:
- 23 (1) a person who holds a license issued under Chapter
- 24 142, 242, 246, 247, or 252;

- 1 (2) a person, establishment, or facility exempt from
- 2 licensing under Section 142.003(a)(19), 242.003(3), or 247.004(4);
- 3 (3) a hotel as defined by Section 156.001, Tax Code;
- 4 (4) a retirement community;
- 5 (5) a monastery or convent;
- 6 (6) a child-care facility as defined by Section
- 7 42.002, Human Resources Code;
- 8 (7) a family violence shelter center as defined by
- 9 Section 51.002, Human Resources Code; or
- 10 (8) a sorority or fraternity house or other dormitory
- 11 associated with an institution of higher education.
- 12 Sec. 767.003 [769.003]. CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD
- 13 INFORMATION REQUIREMENT FOR APPLICANTS AND EMPLOYEES; REQUIRED
- 14 RETENTION; CRIMINAL PENALTIES [PENALTY]. (a) An owner or operator
- 15 of a group home shall obtain criminal history record information
- 16 maintained by the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas
- 17 on each individual who is an applicant for employment with or an
- 18 employee of the group home. The owner or operator of a group home
- 19 shall maintain the criminal history record information described by
- 20 this subsection:
- 21 (1) for an applicant who is not hired, for not less
- 22 than 30 days after the date the position for which the applicant
- 23 applied is filled; and
- 24 (2) for an applicant who is hired, for the duration of
- 25 the employee's employment at the group home.
- 26 (a-1) The owner or operator of a group home may maintain the
- 27 criminal history record information described by Subsection (a) in

1 <u>either a physical or electronic format.</u>

- 2 (b) An owner or operator of a group home may not hire or
- 3 continue to employ an individual for whom the owner or operator
- 4 obtains criminal history record information on the applicant's or
- 5 employee's conviction of an offense under Chapter 19, 20, 20A, 21,
- 6 22, 25, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 33A, 34, 35, 35A, or 71, Penal Code,
- 7 or Section 48.015, 48.02, 48.03, or 48.04, Penal Code, or any other
- 8 offense punishable as a Class A misdemeanor or a felony.
- 9 (c) An owner or operator of a group home who violates
- 10 Subsection (a) or (b) commits an offense. An offense under
- 11 Subsection (a) is a Class B misdemeanor. An offense under
- 12 Subsection (b) [this section] is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 767.003, Health and Safety Code, as
- 14 amended by this Act, applies only to an application for employment
- 15 submitted on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 17 over another Act of the 89th Legislature, Regular Session, 2025,
- 18 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 19 codes.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
