- 10 SECTION 2. Section 372.053(a-1), Transportation Code, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (a-1) A program established under Subsection (a) must
- 13 include free or discounted use of the entity's toll project by an
- 14 electronic toll collection customer whose account relates to a
- 15 vehicle registered under Section 504.202, 504.2025, or 504.315(f)
- 16 or (g).
- SECTION 3. Section 502.410(b), Transportation Code, as
- 18 effective July 1, 2025, is amended to read as follows:
- 19 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a statement or
- 20 application filed or given under Section 502.060, 502.093, 502.094,
- 21 502.095, 504.201, 504.202(b-1), <u>504.2025(d)</u>, 504.508, or 504.515.
- SECTION 4. Subchapter C, Chapter 504, Transportation Code,
- 23 is amended by adding Section 504.2025 to read as follows:
- Sec. 504.2025. PEACE OFFICERS WITH DISABILITIES. (a) In

- 1 this section, "peace officer" means an individual described by
- 2 Article 2A.001, Code of Criminal Procedure.
- 3 (b) A person entitled to specialty license plates under this
- 4 section may register, for the person's own use, one vehicle without
- 5 payment of any fee paid for or at the time of registration except
- 6 the fee for the license plates. Registration under this section is
- 7 valid for one year.
- 8 <u>(c) A peace officer is entitled to register, for the</u>
- 9 person's own use, motor vehicles under this section if:
- 10 (1) the person is disabled as a result of an injury
- 11 suffered during the course and scope of the person's employment as a
- 12 peace officer; and
- 13 (2) the motor vehicle:
- 14 (A) is owned by the person; and
- 15 (B) has a gross vehicle weight of 18,000 pounds
- 16 or less or is a motor home.
- 17 (d) A person described by Subsection (c) who is eligible to
- 18 receive license plates under Section 504.201 may elect to receive
- 19 license plates under this section that include the symbol described
- 20 by Section 504.201(f). The initial application for license plates
- 21 under this subsection must be accompanied by:
- 22 <u>(1) the written statement required by Section</u>
- 23 504.201(d) certifying that the applicant has a mobility problem
- 24 that substantially impairs the person's ability to ambulate;
- 25 (2) a written statement completed by the chief law
- 26 enforcement officer of the law enforcement agency that employed the
- 27 person, certifying that the person is disabled as a result of an

- 1 injury suffered during the course and scope of the person's
- 2 employment as a peace officer; and
- 3 (3) any other information required for an application
- 4 under this section.
- 5 (e) Other than license plates issued under Subsection (h),
- 6 license plates issued under this section must include:
- 7 (1) the letters "DPO" on the plate if the plate is
- 8 issued for a vehicle other than a motorcycle; and
- 9 (2) the words "Disabled Peace Officer" at the bottom
- 10 of each license plate.
- 11 (f) The fee for the first set of license plates is \$3. There
- 12 is no fee for each additional set of license plates.
- 13 (g) A person who receives license plates under Subsection
- 14 (d) may receive a disabled parking placard under Section 681.004
- 15 for each set of license plates.
- 16 (h) A person entitled to license plates under this section
- 17 may elect to receive license plates issued under Chapter 502 under
- 18 the same conditions for the issuance of license plates under this
- 19 section.
- 20 <u>(i) A license</u> plate with the letters "DPO" may be
- 21 personalized with up to four characters.
- 22 (j) A person entitled to license plates under this section
- 23 may instead use, for a vehicle that meets the requirements of
- 24 Section 504.501 or 504.502, disabled peace officer license plates
- 25 issued by this state that:
- 26 (1) are embossed with an alphanumeric pattern;
- 27 (2) are of a plate design that was issued in the same

- 1 year as the model year of the vehicle;
- 2 (3) are approved for use by the department; and
- 3 (4) include the symbol described by Section
- 4 504.201(f), if the person satisfies the requirements for the
- 5 issuance of license plates under Subsection (d) and elects to
- 6 include the symbol on the plates.
- 7 (k) A reference in law to license plates issued under
- 8 Subsection (d) includes disabled peace officer license plates
- 9 described by Subsection (j)(4).
- 10 SECTION 5. Section 681.004(a), Transportation Code, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (a) A person with a permanent disability may receive:
- 13 (1) two disabled parking placards, if the person does
- 14 not receive a set of special license plates under Section 504.201;
- 15 (2) one disabled parking placard, if the person
- 16 receives a set of special license plates under Section 504.201; or
- 17 (3) two disabled parking placards, if the person
- 18 receives two sets of special license plates under Section
- 19 504.202(b-1) or 504.2025(d).
- SECTION 6. The heading to Section 681.008, Transportation
- 21 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 681.008. PARKING PRIVILEGES: CERTAIN PEACE OFFICERS,
- 23 VETERANS, AND MILITARY AWARD RECIPIENTS.
- SECTION 7. Sections 681.008(a) and (b), Transportation
- 25 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 26 (a) A vehicle may be parked for an unlimited period in a
- 27 parking space or area that is designated specifically for persons

- 1 with physical disabilities if:
- 2 (1) the vehicle:
- 3 (A) displays special license plates issued under
- 4 Section 504.202(b-1) or 504.2025(d); and
- 5 (B) is being operated by or for the
- 6 transportation of the person to whom the plates were issued; or
- 7 (2) the vehicle displays license plates issued by
- 8 another state of the United States that indicate on the face of the
- 9 license plates that the owner or operator of the vehicle is a
- 10 disabled veteran of the United States armed forces.
- 11 (b) A vehicle on which license plates described by
- 12 Subsection (a)(2) or issued under Section 504.202, 504.2025,
- 13 504.308, 504.310, 504.315, 504.316, or 504.319 are displayed is
- 14 exempt from the payment of a parking fee collected through a parking
- 15 meter charged by a governmental authority other than a branch of the
- 16 federal government, when being operated by or for the
- 17 transportation of:
- 18 (1) the person who registered the vehicle under
- 19 Section 504.202(a), 504.2025(b), 504.308, 504.310, 504.315,
- 20 504.316, or 504.319;
- 21 (2) a person described in Section 504.202(b) or
- 22 <u>504.2025(c)</u> if the vehicle is registered under that subsection; or
- 23 (3) the owner or operator of a vehicle displaying
- 24 license plates described by Subsection (a)(2).
- 25 SECTION 8. Section 681.009(e), Transportation Code, is
- 26 amended to read as follows:
- (e) Parking spaces or areas designated for the exclusive use

- 1 of vehicles transporting persons with disabilities may be used by
- 2 vehicles displaying a white on blue shield disabled parking
- 3 placard, license plates issued under Section 504.201, [or]
- 4 504.202(b-1), or 504.2025(d), or a white on red shield disabled
- 5 parking placard.
- 6 SECTION 9. Sections 681.011(a), (b), (l), and (m),
- 7 Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) A person commits an offense if:
- 9 (1) the person stands a vehicle on which are displayed
- 10 license plates issued under Section 504.201, [or] 504.202(b-1), or
- 11 <u>504.2025(d)</u> or a disabled parking placard in a parking space or area
- 12 designated specifically for persons with disabilities by:
- 13 (A) a political subdivision; or
- 14 (B) a person who owns or controls private
- 15 property used for parking as to which a political subdivision has
- 16 provided for the application of this section under Subsection (f);
- 17 and
- 18 (2) the standing of the vehicle in that parking space
- 19 or area is not authorized by Section 681.006, 681.007, or 681.008.
- 20 (b) A person commits an offense if the person stands a
- 21 vehicle on which license plates issued under Section 504.201, [or]
- 22 504.202(b-1), or 504.2025(d) are not displayed and a disabled
- 23 parking placard is not displayed in a parking space or area
- 24 designated specifically for individuals with disabilities by:
- 25 (1) a political subdivision; or
- 26 (2) a person who owns or controls private property
- 27 used for parking as to which a political subdivision has provided

- 1 for the application of this section under Subsection (f).
- 2 (1) A person commits an offense if the person:
- 3 (1) stands a vehicle on which are displayed license
- 4 plates issued under Section 504.201, [ex] 504.202(b-1), or
- 5 504.2025(d) or a disabled parking placard in a parking space or area
- 6 for which this chapter creates an exemption from payment of a fee or
- 7 penalty imposed by a governmental unit;
- 8 (2) does not have a disability;
- 9 (3) is not transporting a person with disability; and
- 10 (4) does not pay any applicable fee related to
- 11 standing in the space or area imposed by a governmental unit or
- 12 exceeds a limitation on the length of time for standing in the space
- 13 or area.
- 14 (m) Subsections (n) and (o) apply only to a person who
- 15 commits an offense under Subsection (b) when the vehicle:
- 16 (1) displays special license plates issued under:
- 17 (A) Section 504.202 other than special license
- 18 plates issued under Section 504.202(b-1); or
- 19 (B) Section 504.2025 other than a special license
- 20 plate issued under Section 504.2025(d); and
- 21 (2) does not display a disabled parking placard.
- 22 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
