- 8 <u>a site selection organization selects a site in this state as the</u>
- 9 sole site for the event without considering through a highly
- 10 competitive process one or more sites not in this state. This
- 11 subsection expires September 1, 2030.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
