4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 11.48(a), Tax Code, is amended to read as
6	follows:

- (a) A driver's license number, personal identification 7 certificate number, or social security account number, or the name, age, home address, or home telephone number of a child, provided in 9 an application for an exemption filed with a chief appraiser is 10 confidential and not open to public inspection. The information 11 may not be disclosed to anyone other than an employee or agent of 12 13 the appraisal district who appraises property or performs appraisal 14 services for the appraisal district, except as authorized by 15 Subsection (b).
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
