(a) In this section: 8 (1) "Commercial food waste composting ordinance" 9 10 means a municipal ordinance that requires a multifamily residential property, a business holding a food permit, or another business 11 12 owner to divert food waste from disposal in a landfill. 13 (2) "Composting facility" means a facility that 14 composts source-separated yard trimmings, clean wood material, 15 vegetative material, paper, manure, meat, fish, dead animal carcasses, dairy materials, or meat and vegetable oils and greases 16 from a municipal, commercial, or institutional source. 17 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (e), a person may not 18 deposit at a composting facility located in a county that does not 19 contain a municipality with a commercial food waste composting 20 ordinance food waste that is: 21 22 (1) collected for composting in a municipality that

has a commercial food waste composting ordinance; and

(2) subject to such an ordinance.

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- 1 (c) A person is liable for a civil penalty of \$1,000 for each
- 2 violation of Subsection (b).
- 3 (d) The attorney general may bring an action in a court of
- 4 competent jurisdiction to recover the civil penalty imposed under
- 5 this section.
- 6 (e) This section does not apply to:
- 7 (1) an agricultural operation as defined by Section
- 8 251.002, Agriculture Code;
- 9 <u>(2) a composting facility located in a county</u>
- 10 described by Subsection (b) if the commissioners court of the
- 11 county by resolution or order authorizes the deposit of food waste
- 12 subject to a commercial food waste composting ordinance at the
- 13 facility; or
- 14 (3) a composting facility that:
- 15 (A) is authorized to operate under a valid
- 16 notification issued by the commission on or before January 1, 2025;
- 17 <u>and</u>
- 18 (B) accepted food waste described by Subsection
- 19 (b) before January 1, 2025.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
